To D-1 / D-2 NSAA State Boys Basketball Qualifiers:

We are pleased and excited to be hosting the first day of the D-1 / D-2 NSAA State Boys Basketball Tournament here at Lincoln East. In an effort to make this an enjoyable and memorable experience for your team, school, and community, we would like to provide some additional information and reminders.

- The main ticket entrance will be on the south side of East High School (Door 21). General parking is the Seacrest Field parking lot located south and east of the gym doors. This is our student lot, but school will not be in session that day, so parking should be plentiful. The easiest access to this lot is to enter off of A Street, approximately 3 blocks east of 70th and then drive back north toward the school.
- Team buses, spirit buses and band buses will need to drop off passengers near the main south-side entrance doors and then will be directed to one of the available cut outs to park. A security person will be monitoring traffic in this area.
- The Main Entrance will be open 1 hour prior to the tournament.
- Bands—Enter through the PASS GATE at the Main Entrance. Please have a school check (personal checks are not accepted) made out to the NSAA for the entire band/cheerleader entourage or consigned tickets for the number entering the PASS GATE. You will not be able to purchase individual tickets at the PASS GATE, just the group school check. (Adults--\$7.00, Students--\$5.00) **Please let us know if your band will be attending so we can accommodate their seating.**
- Your Team/Manager/Coaches will be admitted from an NSAA supplied Pass List. Supervisors will need to clearly display the NSAA identification tags that they provide to each school.
- Videotaping—We will have a designated area for one team camera. Please see the floor manager for help.
- Team Picture—The North Balcony will be used for team pictures.
- Coaches—At the end of each game, it is expected that you would take your team off of the court and into the locker room in order for us to prepare the floor for the next game. Players will not be allowed to return to the court after the game, but there will be a place for players to meet parents and fans following each game. Team hosts will direct them to that area. In order to accommodate the next team using your locker room, please finish using the locker room PRIOR to going upstairs to meet friends and family.
- **General Reminders:** a.) no noise makers, b.) no confetti, c.) signs are allowed, but must be positive in nature- Please see the floor manager for the proper place to hang signs on the walls, d.) there is **NO SMOKING** on Lincoln East / Lincoln Public Schools grounds.
- There will be a hospitality room available for team’s coaches and administrators.
