- 1) Applicants must be going into second semester or second year of studying building and/or home maintenance vocational skills at North Platte Community College.
- 2) Applicants must be a US citizen and reside in one of the Nebraska counties of Custer, Dawson, Frontier, Hayes, Hooker, Keith, Lincoln, Logan, McPherson, Perkins or Thomas.
- 3) Applicants must have a grade point average of at least 2.8 on a 4.0 scale for most recent school year.
- 4) Applicants must demonstrate moderate to substantial financial need.
