Through its Construction Education Foundation the Kansas Contractors Association offers scholarships ranging from \$500 up to \$2,500 for any student enrolled or intending to enroll for the 2023-2024 school year in a construction management, construction science, construction engineering technology or related field of study at an accredited Kansas university, community college or technical college.

Eligibility

- Enrolled or intending to enroll in a Kansas university, community college or technical college for the 2023-2024 school year.
- Enrolled or planning to enroll in a degree program related to a career in heavy construction, such as roads, bridges, utilities or railroads.

- All completed applications will be reviewed by the Construction Education Foundation committee.
- Scholarship funds will be sent directly to the recipient's college or university in their name for disbursement.
